DECISION

No. 7

On refusal in admission of the candidate for the position of the High Council of Justice to the interview

Having considered the issue on admission or refusal in admission of candidates for the position of the member of the High Council of Justice to the interview in line with the Law of Ukraine "On the High Council of Justice", Rules of Procedure of the Ethics Council adopted by Decision No. 4 of the Ethics Council as of 9 December 2021, the Ethics Council consisting of Chair of the Ethics Council Lev Kyshakevych, Deputy Chair of the Ethics Council Sir Anthony Hooper, members of the Council: Yurii Triasun, Volodymyr Siverin, Robert Cordy (in the videoconference mode), Lavly Perling (in the videoconference mode)

has established:

pursuant to the Opinion on Results of the Special Check of candidate for the position of the member of the High Council of Justice Serhii Yuldashev provided by the High Council of Justice, there has been revealed information that prevents Serhii Yuldashev from filling in a responsible or especially responsible position or position with an increased corruption risk.

In line with Article 9(7) of the Law of Ukraine "On the High Council of Justice", in case results of the special check reveal information about a candidate that does not comply with requirements for the position set out by the legislation, such candidate terminates participation in the competition for the position of the member of the High Council of Justice.

Thus, being governed by cl. 3.7.1., 3.7.2. of the Ethics Council's Rules of Procedure, Article 9¹, Article 9(7) of the Law of Ukraine "On the High Council of Justice", the Ethics Council

has decided:

to refuse in admission of candidate to the	position of the member	of the High Council
of Justice Serhii Yuldashev.
